3. HAZARDS IDENTIFICATION

MAIN HAZARDS: Irritating to skin. Risk of serious damage to eyes.

4. FIRST AID MEASURES

INHALATION: There may be irritation of the throat with a feeling of tightness in the chest. Remove casualty from exposure ensuring ones own safety whilst doing so. Consult a doctor.
INGESTION: There may be soreness and redness of the throat and mouth. Nausea and stomach pain may occur. Wash out mouth with water. DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING. If conscious, give half a litre of water to drink immediately. Consult a doctor.
SKIN: There may be irritation and redness at site of contact. Remove all contaminated clothes and footwear immediately unless stuck to skin. Wash immediately with plenty soapy water.
EYES: There may be pain and redness. The eyes may water profusely. There may be severe pain. The vision may become blurred. May cause permanent damage. Bathe the eye with running water for 15 minutes. Transfer to hospital for specialist examination.

5. FIRE FIGHTING MEASURES

EXTINGUISHING MEDIA: Suitable extinguishing media for the surrounding fire should be used. Use water spray to cool containers.
EXPOSURE HAZARDS: In combustion emits toxic fumes.
PROTECTION OF FIRE FIGHTERS: Wear self-contained breathing apparatus. Wear protective clothing to prevent contact with skin and eyes.

6. ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

SPILL CLEAN UP METHODS: Transfer to a closable, labelled salvage container for disposal by an appropriate methods.
ENVIRONMENTAL PRECAUTIONS: Do not discharge into rivers.
